By the end of the twenty-seventh month, your toddler will probably:

Mental Development of 27 month old child

- Continue to convey his feelings with gestures and actions, despite verbal ability
- Be acquiring about 50 new words a month
- Create words if he doesn't know the right one to express his idea
- Chatter constantly

Visual Development of 27 month old child

• Like to watch the movement of wheels and other things that turn or spin

Growth of 27 month old child

- Weigh about 12.5 kg (girl) or about 13.1 kg (boy)
- Be about 88 cm in height (girl) or about 89.5 cm in height (boy)

Motor Development of 27 month old child

- Start to unwrap objects
- Be able to run, although he may trip or have trouble coming to a stop
- Be able to climb up almost anything, although he may have trouble getting down
- Be able to jump, getting both feet off the floor

Social and Emotional Development of 27 month old child

- Show more signs of independence—"me do it" is his motto
- Test limits, but respond to consistent, reasonable discipline
- Respond well to a consistent schedule of daily activities

Toddler Development Tracker details are provided to give indications on the expected changes during different months, however, these changes varies from child to child and the mother needs to consult her child's doctor, if she has any concerns.
